



## **ST ANDREW'S SCHOOL (SECONDARY) DSA-SEC EXERCISE**

### **ADMISSION & SELECTION CRITERIA**

1. Our school is offering the following talent areas for the 2026 DSA-Sec exercise: Concert Band, Football, Hockey, Rugby, Squash, Water Polo, Student Leadership and Visual Arts.
2. Application will be opened to male Primary 6 Singaporean, Singapore PR and international students who have outstanding talent in the offered talent areas. Interested students may browse through our school website for more information on the talent areas offered.
3. Please refer to the table for the selection criteria in the different talent areas. Note that meeting all the criteria does not guarantee that the applicant will be shortlisted or given an offer.
4. Applicants who do not have prior experience may also apply. The school will assess applicants based on the selection criteria, which may include assessing the potential of the applicants.
5. Students and parents may submit applications for DSA-Sec via the MOE DSA-Sec website, [www.moe.gov.sg/dsa-sec](http://www.moe.gov.sg/dsa-sec), from **6 May 2026, 11:00 AM to 2 June 2026, 4:30 PM**. The application is free-of-charge. Applicants only need to fill in one online form to apply to multiple schools and talent areas. Each applicant can indicate up to three choices in the application form. For each choice, applicants will need to choose a secondary school and a talent area offered by that school. Applicants can indicate a different talent area for each of his three choices, and a maximum of two choices may be used for the same school.
6. Shortlisted applicants will receive notification from the school for the trial, audition or interview **after 30 June 2026**, if your child has been shortlisted to undergo Direct School Admission (DSA) selection. All applicants will receive their application outcomes from us between **17 August and 28 August 2026**.
7. Parents and students are encouraged to choose schools wisely based on the student's aptitudes and strengths, bearing in mind the schools' academic and non-academic requirements, and the programmes available to develop the area of talent.



8. In accepting an offer of admission through the DSA Exercise, students are expressing a commitment to study in that school, and to develop their talent in their chosen area. Hence students who are successfully admitted to a school via DSA-Sec will not be eligible to participate in the S1 Posting Exercise or Joint Admissions Exercise. They will also not be allowed to transfer to another school after obtaining their PSLE results. Students who are successfully admitted to the school via DSA are required to honour their commitment to the school and participate in the activities related to the talent they are selected for from year 1 to 4.

## **FAQs**

1. What is Direct School Admission (DSA)?

Direct School Admission (DSA) gives schools flexibility in selecting students in the talent areas as specified by the individual schools. This also allows Primary 6 students to be recognised for a more diverse range of achievements and talents.

2. Is there an admission quota for DSA in St Andrew's School (Secondary)?

St Andrew's School (Secondary) admits up to 20% of our Secondary 1 students through DSA.

3. How much flexibility is given to St Andrew's School (Secondary) in terms of choosing students?

The school decides our own talent area criteria. Students offered a place in our school through DSA-Sec will be admitted into the posting groups based on their PSLE results.

4. Can I apply to St Andrew's School (Secondary) through another CCA not listed in the school's talent areas?

No. Applicants through the DSA-Sec Exercise may only apply through the talent areas listed.

5. Must I still sit for PSLE if I have received a Confirmed Offer (CO) from St Andrew's School (Secondary)?

Yes, students must sit for the PSLE even though they have received a Confirmed Offer (CO) from St Andrew's School (Secondary).

6. Can a student in Primary 5 apply for DSA?

No, admission to Secondary 1 is only for Primary 6 students or its equivalent.

7. Can I still opt for St Andrew's School (Secondary) in the Sec 1 Posting Exercise if I do not make it through the selection rounds?

Yes, you can still choose St Andrew's Secondary School in the Centralised Posting Exercise after you have received your PSLE results. Admission will be based on your PSLE results and the number of places in the school.

8. Can I apply for more than one talent area in St Andrew's School (Secondary)?

Yes, you can apply for more than one talent area but you will only be offered ONE programme. For instance, if you apply for DSA through both rugby and hockey, you will only receive a Confirmed Offer for either rugby or hockey if you successfully pass the trial and interview.



9. How does St Andrew's School (Secondary) select the students?

Selection is conducted through face-to-face trials/auditions by the respective CCA teachers and coaches/instructors. There will also be an interview/group task conducted with the CCA teachers, selected key personnel and school leaders.

10. When will I be notified of the trials and interviews?

The respective CCA teachers will inform you of the details via email after **30 June 2026**.

11. Will I receive a notification if I am not shortlisted for the trial/audition and/or interview/group task?

You will not receive a notification if you are not shortlisted.

12. Do I still have to take part in the MOE Posting Exercise if I am given a Confirmed Offer (CO) by St Andrew's School (Secondary)?

Students successfully allocated to their DSA-Sec schools will **NOT** be allowed to participate in the annual Secondary 1 Posting Exercise to opt for secondary schools and are expected to honour their commitment to the allocated DSA-Sec school for the entire duration of the programme. They will also **NOT** be allowed to transfer to another school after the release of the PSLE results.

13. Do successful DSA-Student Leadership/Visual Arts applicants need to take up a CCA?

Yes, all students will need to join a CCA as it is an integral part of holistic education. Students admitted through DSA Student Leadership/Visual Arts, will be assigned a CCA during the CCA selection process at Secondary 1. The CCA assigned will be based on student interest and vacancy in the CCA.
